Neither entry nor fee payments will be accepted after those dates.

**Reimbursement** The registration fees paid for any reason shall not be reimbursed with the exception of cases where a water polo team is not willing to compete in the age group immediately preceding if fewer than three teams registered in its age group.

Registration is individual: transfer of a registration is not allowed.

**FINA Affiliation** All Masters competitors must be registered with a FINA Member Federation and provide proof with a Masters License, Club Registration Card or Federation membership card.

Club registration information is requested during the on-line entry to all competitors and will be verified at the accreditation centre.

**Participants entry** Only competitors, team representatives and referee provided by Water Polo teams shall register. Coaches don't have to register nor pay any fee.

**Accompanying persons** Accompanying persons don't need registration and must not do on-line registration nor pay any fee.

**Entry Procedure** *Individual entries* have to be done individually on-line only by competitors by:

- completing the relevant sections on the personal data form;
- checking the appropriate box (signs the privacy waiver and the waiver of liability, transfer of rights and permission for photographic use);
- validating the email by click on the validation link;
- completing the personal data form with phone number, National Federation name, Master Club name and Masters Club Registration Number;
- uploading a portrait photo;
- checking e-mail used for registration where access credit (username and password) will be sent. Those credits will be used to access to the personal account of the website;
- entering competition events (when it will be available\*);
- proceeding with checkout and payment (when it will be available\*);
- receiving your receipt (when it will be available\*).

**Team representative** must register themselves using the “team representative” button by:

- completing the relevant sections on the personal data form;
- checking the appropriate box (signs the privacy waiver and the transfer of rights and permission for photographic use);
- validating the email by click on the validation link;
- completing the personal data form with phone number, Club National Federation name, Master Club name represented;
- uploading a portrait photo;
- checking e-mail used for registration where access credit (username and password) will be sent. Those credits will be used to access to the personal account of the website;
- entering competition events (when it will be available\*);
- • composing teams with names of competitors and notifying the provided referee if any (when it will be available\*);
- proceeding with checkout and payment (when it will be available\*);
- receiving your receipt (when it will be available\*).

Team representatives will be able to register teams and associate names of competitors (previously individually registered) and referee (previously individually registered).

**Referee** must individually register themselves using the “Referee” button by:

- completing the relevant sections on the personal data form;
- checking the appropriate box (signs the privacy waiver and the transfer of rights and permission for photographic use);
- validating the email by click on the validation link;
- completing the personal data form with phone number, Club National Federation name providing it, Master Club name

- providing it;
- uploading a portrait photo;
- checking e-mail used for registration where access credit (username and password) will be sent. Those credits will be used to access to the personal account of the website;
- receiving your receipt (when it will be available\*).

\* some features will be soon activated. The activation will be announced with an e-mail.

**Results**

All results will be published on the Internet on [www.finamasters2012.org](http://www.finamasters2012.org) and will be available for inspection at the Information Point.

FINA Masters Rules will be applied for all disciplines of the 14th FINA Masters Championships. It is competitor's responsibility to know the above mentioned Rules. The FINA Rules are available on the website [www.fina.org](http://www.fina.org).

**Competition regulations**

Any competitor who acts in an unsportsmanlike or unsafe manner within the competition venues may be considered for appropriate action or penalty by the FINA Master Commission. Pull-buoys, kick boards, fins, hand paddles and other training aids considered inappropriate are not allowed in the competition and warm up areas as well as watches and heavy jewellery.

**IMPORTANT:** No one may smoke in any of the pool complexes or on the pool deck and surrounding areas.
